## PEST CONTROL SERVICES

We have been contracted by the management of this building to carry out a pest control service program in the premises occupied by you. This service is being performed to Monitor and Treat for **MICE** infestation.

We require access to your suite between the hours of **8 AM and 4 PM.**

**NOTE: If you are unable to accommodate this appointment, please contact your resident manager immediately.**

There are no special preparations required and there is no need to evacuate the suites.

### **NOTE:**

- The mouse bait which is used is Toxic **only** if swallowed, and does not cause any side effects by just being placed in the units.
- The bait will be placed behind the stove and/or be placed along the heating register. In units with pets, the bait will be placed in areas not accessible to pets.
- The bait stations and any monitoring traps are **non-toxic**.
- It is recommended that the bait be left in place for at least 6-8 weeks, thereafter it can be properly disposed of.
- **Keep bait away from children and pets.** Important: In case of ingestion please consult your physician or veterinarian. The anti-dote is Vitamin K.

## Frequently Asked Questions

❖ **Can I tell if I have deer mice based upon the droppings?**

There is a slight difference between the droppings, however it is not enough to make a positive identification. Since the droppings basically look the same we recommend that all mice droppings be treated with caution.

❖ **What is Hanta-Virus and how can I get it?**

This is a virus that is found in some deer mice droppings. It can cause Deadly Hantavirus Pulmonary Syndrome if droppings are improperly cleaned up. Do not vacuum or sweep up the droppings as this can cause them to become airborne and get into your body.

❖ **Will there be a smell when the mice die?**

-No. With our mice bait, it dries the mice up so there is no odor. If you notice a smell, it is from a mouse that has died of natural causes.

❖ **What can I do to prevent mice?**

-You should seal up entry points, and ensure that you aren't attracting the mice inside. Make sure your food items and pet food are in sealed containers, and that standing water isn't easily accessible.

❖ **How do I clean up mice droppings?**

-You should use a wet method (bleach and water) to clean up the droppings. In cases where there are a great deal of droppings it is recommended to get professionals to come in and clean up the droppings.
