



BEDBUG SPRAY TREATMENT THREE (3) SPRAY METHOD

We have been contracted to provide a pesticide application for the control of Bedbugs.

We require access to your place between the hours of **9 AM and 5 PM**.

As a precaution during the application of the pesticide, we require that you vacate your suite for **4 - 6 hours** from the time of application.

NOTE: If you are unable to accommodate this appointment, please contact your Property Management and/or Ecopest immediately. Ecopest is not responsible for any stains or damage that may occur.

For our service technicians to treat most effectively, we ask your co-operation in carrying out the following instructions:

1. All baseboards need to be loosened from the wall approximately 1/2 inch so the treatment can be applied behind the baseboards. Do not replace baseboards until all the three (3) treatments are done.
2. In your **bedroom**: Move all furniture at least **2 feet** away from the walls. Also remove the mattress and boxsprings from bed frames and lean them against the wall with room for our technicians to work around them.
3. Please wash all laundry in **hot** water that may be infested (all recently used items including bedding). We recommend bagging the clothing as the treatments are carried out. Remove all clothing and items from floors, drawers, and the bottom of closets (hanging can remain).
4. In your **living rooms**: Move all furniture at least **2 feet** away from the walls. Heavy wall units may remain. Birds and pets must be removed from the premises, and fish tanks (if any) **must** be covered and the motors turned off, to prevent any possibility of poisoning.
5. Children's toys should be placed in plastic bags or covered toy boxes.
6. Don't place items on **beds, sofas and/or chairs**
7. Unplug all cords from outlets, and cover TV's, computers, and other electronic items to prevent any spray from getting on them.

NOTE: Upon re-entry to your premises, **ensure that fresh linen is placed on all beds. Do not wash any of the baseboards or bed frames for a period of at least six weeks. The pesticide has residual effects which would be lessened by washing.** Kitchen counter tops, cutting boards, fridge and stove tops should be washed prior to any items being returned to them. Vacuum after treatment especially along the baseboards, use crevice tool to get into corners and cracks, also vacuum seams of box spring units, mattresses and associated bedroom and upholstered furniture in the living room. Regular vacuuming should be done because cleanliness and sanitation is a vital part of eradication and successful treatment.

Where pregnancies, allergies, illnesses or other unusual conditions exist, occupants may wish to remain out of the premises for periods longer than 6 hours.
